

Tuition Fees Regulation for the Academic Year 2026–2027

Article 1 General Provisions

(1) This Regulation sets out provisions for establishing the amounts of tuition fees and other fees, charges, and rents collected by the University for the academic year 2026–2027.

Article 2 Students and Candidates

(1) In accordance with the provisions of the Regulation on the Organization of Teaching Activities (ROAD), the University's students fall into one of the following categories:

- (a) Romanian citizens domiciled in Romania;
- (b) Romanian citizens domiciled abroad;
- (c) foreign citizens of Romanian ethnicity;
- (d) citizens of Member States of the European Union, of States belonging to the European Economic Area, and of the Swiss Confederation, as well as British citizens and their family members, as beneficiaries of the Agreement on the withdrawal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland from the European Union and from the European Atomic Energy Community 2019/C 384 I/01;
- (e) citizens who do not fall under categories (a), (b), (c) and (d), who benefit from subsidiary protection, have refugee status, or are family members of a Romanian citizen;
- (f) citizens who do not fall under categories (a), (b), (c), (d) and (e).

(2) Depending on the form of study financing, a student has one of the following funding statuses:

- (a) tuition-free, for studies financed through grants allocated by the Ministry of Education;
- (b) tuition-fee-paying, for studies financed by the student or any other third party, and for studies partially financed through grants awarded by the Technical University of Civil Engineering Bucharest.

(3) Candidates referred to in Article 1(f) may pursue university studies:

- (a) on tuition-fee-paying places;

or

- (b) on state-budget-funded places, in the case of Romanian state scholarship holders designated by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Ministry of Education and

Research and other competent institutions, on places specifically allocated to this category.

(4) Depending on the form of study financing, a trainee enrolled in the non-university study college has one of the following funding statuses:

(a) tuition-free;

or

(b) tuition-fee-paying.

Article 3 Tuition Fees

(1) Tuition fees for students enrolled under the tuition-fee-paying funding status are established in accordance with the provisions of Table 1 and Table 2.

(4) The payment deadlines for each instalment of the tuition fee, for students enrolled in undergraduate (Bachelor's) or Master's university study programs, are:

(a) for instalment 1 – in the period immediately following the admission competition, according to the calendar, before enrolment;

(b) for instalment 2 – the last working day of the penultimate week of teaching activities in Semester I;

(c) for instalment 3 – the last working day of the penultimate week of teaching activities in Semester II.

(5) The tuition fee for students enrolled in postgraduate professional conversion study programs is paid in two separate instalments of equal value. The payment deadlines for each instalment are:

(a) for instalment 1 – in the period immediately following the admission competition, according to the calendar, before enrolment;

(b) for instalment 2 – the last working day of the penultimate week of teaching activities in Semester I.

(6) The tuition fee for students enrolled in the "Romanian Language Preparatory Year" study program is paid in two separate instalments of equal value. The payment deadlines for each instalment are:

(a) for instalment 1 – the last working day of the third week of October, before enrolment;

(b) for instalment 2 – the last working day of the third week of March.

(7) Tuition fees for students referred to in Article 2(1)(f) and Article 2(3)(a), enrolled in undergraduate (Bachelor's), Master's, or doctoral university study programs, are paid in a single instalment. The payment deadline is established in accordance with paragraph (4) for all students, except for students enrolled in Year I, for whom the payment deadline is the last working day of the third week of October of the academic year.

Article 4 Fees for Registration for the Admission Competition

(1) The fees for registration for the admission competition, applicable to all candidates for the admission competition held at the end of the academic year, are established in accordance with the provisions of Table 5.

(1) The rent amounts for different types of spaces and activities are established in accordance with the provisions of Table 8.

The accommodation fee includes the cost of 100 kWh/month/room of electricity consumption. If electricity consumption exceeds 100 kWh/month/room, the accommodated persons shall pay the difference in consumption, in addition to the accommodation fee. Consumption of up to 100 kWh/month is not carried over from one month to the next.		

(2) VAT shall be added to the rent amounts indicated in (1).

(3) For the sports hall, utility costs shall be paid separately from the rent amount established in accordance with the provisions of (1)

Article 8 Parking on University premises

(1) Access of vehicles to the university premises is at the sole risk of the driver and/or the vehicle owner.

(2) The University shall not be liable for any event, incident or damage (including theft, attempted theft, vandalism, damage, accidents, fire, natural phenomena, falling objects or incidents caused by third parties) affecting vehicles and/or the goods inside them, regardless of whether the vehicles are in motion, stopped or parked on the university premises.

(3) The parking access permit is personal and non-transferable and is issued for one single vehicle, identified in the application and in the University's records.

(4) Under these regulations, the University may provide night–day parking spaces on its own premises, within the limits of available capacity and in compliance with the campus access and traffic rules.

(5) The number of night–day parking spaces is limited for each campus, as follows:

(a) Plevnei Campus: 2 spaces;

(b) Tei Campus: 15 spaces;

(c) Colentina Campus: 3 spaces;

(d) Pache Protopopescu Campus: 5 spaces.

(6) Night–day parking spaces may be allocated to persons who are:

(a) employed by the University under an open-ended individual employment contract; and

(b) involved in the University’s activities, including activities requiring presence/operations outside normal working hours.

The allocation of spaces is made by decision of the Administrative Council, based on a substantiated request sent to secretariat.dga@utcb.ro by the end of January.

(7) The request addressed to the Administrative Council must obligatorily include:

(a) the purpose for which night–day parking is requested;

(b) a brief description (a few lines) of the actual activities for which parking is necessary, including, where applicable, activities carried out outside the current duties/job description.

(8) Night–day parking spaces are established and communicated to beneficiaries through the premises/campus plan, with clear marking of locations, so that access routes, manoeuvres, logistical activities and/or the performance of works (including construction sites) on campus are not affected.

Article 9 Other Provisions

(1) The fees provided for in these regulations do not include interbank fees or differences resulting from foreign exchange rates, which shall be borne by the person making the payment.

(2) For the purposes of these regulations, “urgent processing” means the issuance of documents within 10 working days. “Standard processing” means the issuance of documents within 20 working days.
